

Jim Crow Laws

1.) "All passenger stations in this state operated by any carrier in transportation company shall have separate waiting rooms or open accommodations suitable for the white and colored races." (Alabama)

2.) "Every person... operating... any public hall, theater, opera house, meeting place or any place of public entertainment or public amusement which is attended by both white and colored persons, shall separate the white race and the colored race and shall not admit both together... it shall not be an unlawful discrimination under this statute... to be accepted by colored persons." (Virginia)

3.) "All schools... children must be segregated by race." (Mississippi)

4.) "Separate facilities required for white and black citizens in airports." (Texas)

5.) "All contact between a white person and a Negro... are... prohibited." (Florida)

6.) "Any person who shall own any part of any multi-building or a Negro person or a Negro family who is residing in a house in which he occupies for a dwelling or in which he is otherwise residing in any city or town shall be considered by a Negro person or Negro family, shall be guilty of a crime." (California)

7.) "The states and territories for the purpose shall be separate from the white race and may be further more separated."

8.) "The Constitution shall have the right to make regulations of the white and colored races so as to the care of all rights of living, working and trading." (Mississippi)

9.) "Separate the two races shall be established for the education of children of both race classes, and it shall be unlawful for any person to discriminate against white school, or any other school or school building." (Mississippi)
