Roles:

1. Summarizer
2. Illustrator
3. Quotes Expert
4. Investigator

Job Script:

1. Summarizer

Your job is to prepare a summary of the reading. Don't tell the whole story, just focus on the important parts. The other members of your group will be counting on you to give them a quick statement that tells about the story (the summary), and the key points.

2. Illustrator

Your job is to draw what you read. This might mean drawing a scene or a cartoon-like sequence, or an important scene or reader's favorite moment for action. Label your drawings and characters. (2 drawings per chapter)

3. Quotes Expert

You find quotes from the chapters which are memorable, interesting, puzzling and important. Your notes should include who said them, what you want to say about them. (minimum 11 quotes per chapter)

4. Investigator

You watch out for words worth learning. Find out the meaning of these words. If possible, attach a picture to the words. These words might be interesting, new, important or used in unusual ways. It is important to make use of the specific location of the words.
