

Non-Fiction Text Feature Matching-Upper Elementary Level

<b>Tables, Charts, Graphs</b>	Words written close to a picture or photograph to help the reader understand the picture or photograph
<b>Photographs/Illustrations</b>	Helps reader understand something by looking at it from the inside
<b>Captions</b>	Helps the reader identify key topics in the book in the order they are presented
<b>Cutaway</b>	Help the reader understand where places are in the world
<b>Table of Contents</b>	Helps the reader to know which words or ideas are important. Words might be, <u>underlined</u> , <b>bold</b> or in <i>italics</i>
<b>Glossary</b>	An alphabetical list of almost everything in the text, with page numbers
<b>Index</b>	Gives the reader a general idea what the text will be about
<b>Maps</b>	Help the reader identify a photograph or a picture and its parts
<b>Special Print</b>	Help the reader know exactly what something looks like
<b>Titles/Subtitles</b>	Helps the reader define words that are in the book
<b>Labels</b>	Help the reader see information in a diagram form
