

Amazing Animals-Reader's Theater Script

Narrator 1	Bug eyes, long beak, thick fur, big squeak!
Narrator 2	Animals have many things that help them live.
Polar Bear 1	A polar bear has thick fur. Each hair is shaped like a tube. The hair is clear, like glass. The sun makes it look white. How does thick white fur help?
Polar Bear 2	Thick fur helps polar bears stay warm. The color of their fur looks the same color as snow. This helps them hide. Where is this little polar bear hiding?
Elephant 1	An elephant has two long teeth and a long nose. The teeth are called tusks. The nose is called a trunk. How do tusks and a trunk help?
Elephant 2	Elephants use their tusks to scrape bark off trees. Then they eat the bark. Elephants use their trunk to get water. Sometimes they spray water at each other!
Camel 1	Some kinds of camels have only one hump. Some have two. All camels have two rows of eyelashes. How do humps and thick eyelashes help?
Camel 2	A camel's hump has fat inside. On long trips, a camel's body uses the fat for food. A camel's eyelashes keep out the desert sand. Look at these long eyelashes!
Duck 1	A duck has webbed feet. Each foot has three toes. A duck has a beak, too. How do webbed feet and a beak help?
Duck 2	Ducks use their webbed feet as paddles. Webbed feet help ducks swim fast. Ducks use their beaks to eat plants. This duck uses its beak to clean its friend.
Giraffe 1	A giraffe has spots. A giraffe has long neck. How do spots and a long neck help?
Giraffe 2	A giraffe's spots help it hide. The giraffe's long neck helps it reach the leaves of trees. This giraffe is bending her long neck down to kiss her little giraffe!
