

To color the flag of Australia color the shapes numbered 1 in red and the shapes numbered 2 in blue. Leave the rest white.

Did you know? Australia Day, January 26, is the day Australians remember the country's long history and celebrate its achievements. On January 26, 1788, Captain Arthur Phillip first flew the British flag over Port Jackson (later named Sydney Cove). The country's government was established on January 1, 1901 when the states of Tasmania, Victoria, New South Wales, Queensland, South Australia, and Western Australia formed a federation, the **Commonwealth of Australia**. The Northern Territory was added to the federal commonwealth 10 years later.
