
## this - that - these - those



## Use:

We use "this" for one object (singular) which is here (near to us).

We use "that" for one object (singular) which is there.

We use <u>These</u> for more than one object Example: These are my friends next to (plural) which are <u>here</u> (near to us).

We use <u>Those</u> for more than one object Example: Those are his toys over there (plural) which are <u>there</u>.

Example: This is a book in my hand.

Example: That is his car over there.
