Example of New-Agreed Rule Response:

For example, a growing number of governments are introducing strict laws on firearms. Some people believe this will protect the public's safety, while others believe that the government's involvement in firearms and gun safety legislation can lead to increased crime. Personally speaking, the former view has more sense.

The issue of whether private citizens are eligible to buy, sell or own firearms depends on many factors. While it is true that private citizens generally support gun control and universal laws may not prevent criminal acts entirely, we do know that there are valid positions. Therefore some people will, personally, oppose gun control and be against all gun control.
