

Graciana: Your task is to figure out what each living thing in the drawing below eats and then draw arrows (→) to show what eats up in whose mouth. For example, shrimp eat phytoplankton, so, you would draw an arrow pointing towards the shrimp (→) because the phytoplankton ends up in the mouth of the shrimp. Remember that each living thing can be eaten by more than one thing. (Don't forget about what ends up in the fisherman's mouth! Finally, what does the sea do? Swimming of the animals might get boring, but don't worry about that!
