

Partial Sums

You can use **partial sums** to help you add multi-digit numbers! Use the examples on the left to help you solve these addition problems with partial sums.

$$\begin{array}{r} 145 \\ + 322 \\ \hline \end{array}$$

Find the sum of each place value.

There are 4 hundreds, 4 tens, and 4 ones total.

(These are the partial sums.)

$$\begin{array}{r} 400 \\ + 60 \\ + 7 \\ \hline 467 \end{array}$$

$$\begin{array}{r} 1. \quad 329 \\ + 418 \\ \hline \end{array}$$

$$\begin{array}{r} 2. \quad 371 \\ + 528 \\ \hline \end{array}$$

$$\begin{array}{r} 3. \quad 135 \\ + 721 \\ \hline \end{array}$$

$$\begin{array}{r} 4. \quad 583 \\ + 115 \\ \hline \end{array}$$

$$\begin{array}{r} 6. \quad 394 \\ + 212 \\ \hline \end{array}$$

$$\begin{array}{r} 7. \quad 647 \\ + 351 \\ \hline \end{array}$$
