

### Slam Poetry (also: Spoken Word Poetry, Performance Poetry)

shows are performed by their authors, the audience is often part of these performances.

-> Poetry Slam: a poet(s) or group of adults poems perform their work and are judged by members of the audience (they cheer or boo).

some basic rules: poets perform their own original work  
each poet gets 3 minutes on stage  
the poet may not use props, costumes or instruments
