Quotation Marks

Quotation marks come in pairs. You need one set of quotation marks at the beginning of the title, dialogue or quote and you need one at the end.

Quotation marks in mixed dialogue/conversation

"I had a fantastic time at the pool," Jill said.
She said, "I got all done my math too!"
Jill yelled, "I'm hungry!"

Quotation marks surround some titles, some countries and single quotations

One of my favorite movies is "The Art Bully."
My brother really likes Fred Penner's song "Come Back."

Quotation marks surround some names (not with quotes)

There is this "boy" to help me!
My sister chases with a bunch of "bulbs".
She says she "forgot" her homework.

Commas and periods go inside of the quotation marks.

Quotation marks and exclamation marks go inside IF they are part of the quote, if not, they will go outside the quotation marks.

Some colons and dashes always go outside of the quotation marks.
