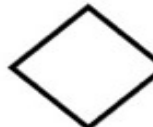
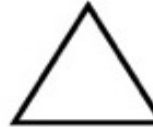
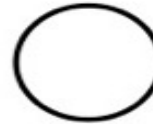
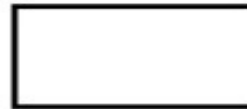
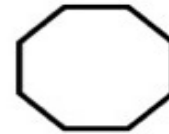


I Read Signs
