



The object of the Rube Goldberg design is to "begin" as many words as possible. It isn't that there is more for the words, but one of them doesn't belong. One word does not rhyme with the other words.

Choose the word that does not rhyme and "begin" it in the next line. If you begin the right word, half of the words in the next line will rhyme and one will not rhyme. Now beginning words with your next line will not. If you begin the right words, the last word will begin all complete the sentence of the song.
