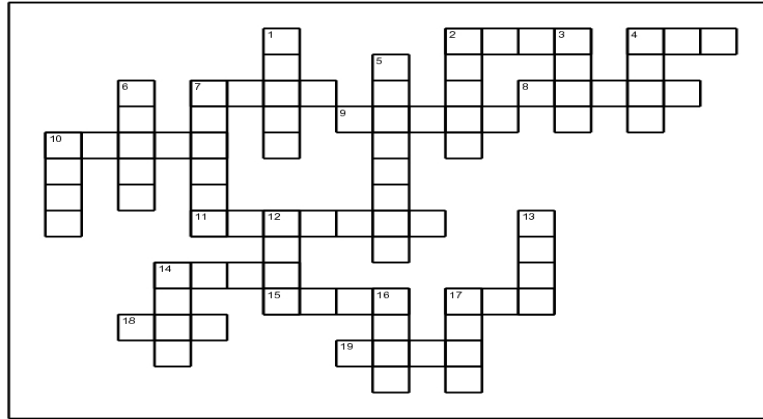


## Harder Homonyms
