CARE!

- 2 1/2 cups carrots
- 2 lg eggs
- 1/2 c sugar
- 1/4 c oil
- 1 tsp vanilla
- 1 c flour
- 1/2 tsp baking powder
- 1/2 tsp baking soda
- 1/2 tsp salt
- 1 tsp cinnamon
- 1/4 c chopped walnuts

FROSTING:

- 1/2 stick unsalted butter
- 4 oz cream cheese
- 1 tsp vanilla
- 1/2 c powdered sugar

Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Grease and flour a 9x9 inch pan. Combine flour, baking powder, baking soda, salt and cinnamon, set aside. Chop carrots, mix together eggs, sugar, oil, and vanilla. Add dry ingredients to mixture. Fold in carrots and walnuts. Bake for 1 hour, or until water comes out clean. To make frosting, mix together all ingredients until smooth. Cover top and sides of cake and garnish with walnut halves.
