

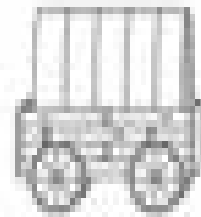
Build a covered wagon!

- Instructions:**
1. Color the panels, axles, and wheels of the wagon.
 2. Cut all pieces out along solid lines. Glue along dashed lines.
 3. Glue sides on wagon base to wagon sides as directed.
 4. Glue axle on sides to wagon base as directed.
 5. Glue panels on sides of wagon base.
 6. Finally glue wheels to sides of panels.

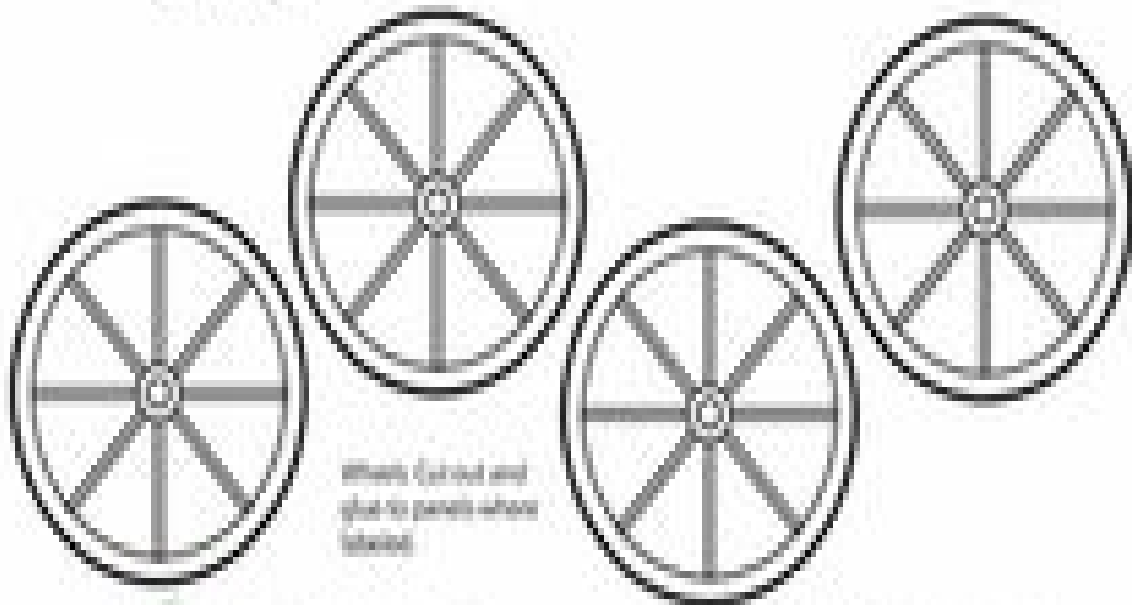
Brain activity: How much weight can your wagon carry?

The pioneers had to pack carefully for their long trip. They needed enough food, tools, and supplies for the long trip, but they had to be careful not to overload the wagon. See how many pennies, paper clips, or building blocks you can pack in the wagon before the wheels begin to bend. Imagine how difficult it must have been to pack a real wagon!
