1. Type of Government
 - a. Monarchy? Parliament? Military? Other?
 - b. Why did you choose this type of government?
2. Social Hierarchy
 - a. What is the place and purpose of the social classes?
3. Military importance and use
 - a. What kind of military do you have?
 - b. How do you use your military?
4. Role of religion
 - a. How do you regard religion in your country?
 - b. Is there more than one religion allowed? Why or why not?
5. Economic strategy
 - a. How does your country get money?
 - b. How does your country spend money?
6. Improvements to your country
 - a. How will you improve the arts, intellectuals, and cities?
 - b. How will you make your country the best place in Europe?
