Fellowship Offering (Peace) (various animals or grain) Leviticus (3:1-17, 6:14-23)	For: Celebrating peace with God and fellowship with others	Ephesians 2:11-22	We have peace with God and others through Christ
Sin Offering (Various animals or flour) Leviticus (4:1-5:13, 6:24-30)	For: Confession of unintentional sin or contact with uncleanness	I John 1:7-10 Romans 12:1-2 Philippians 4:8	Daily confession Daily renewal Daily preparation
Trespass Offering (Guilt or Restitution) (Ram or lamb) Leviticus (5:14-6:7, 7:1-10)	For: Confession of sin toward holy things, or others (lying, etc.) and restitution was required	Romans 12:17-21 Matthew 5:23-24 Hebrews 9:13-14	Be proactive Make things right Experience peace
