

SBI Recruitment 2010: State Bank of India, invites on-line applications from Indian citizens for appointment in Clerical Cadre post in its Associate Banks. Before applying, Candidates should ensure that they fulfill the eligibility criteria for the post. Candidates are requested to apply on-line through Bank's website [www.sbi.co.in](http://www.sbi.co.in) or [www.statebankofindia.com](http://www.statebankofindia.com). For applying on-line, the candidate should have a valid e-mail ID which should be kept alive during the currency of this recruitment exercise. If a candidate does not have a valid e-mail ID, he/she should create new valid e-mail ID before applying on line. The candidate should go to any branch of SBI, pay the amount of fees and get cash receipt with deposit journal number and depositing branch code number. These numbers should be correctly entered while registering an application on-line. No other means/ mode of application/ printout will be accepted.

STATE-WISE VACANCIES IN STATE BANK OF BIKANER & JAIPUR

Nationality / Citizenship :

A candidate must be either (i) a Citizen of India or (ii) a subject of Nepal or

(iii) a subject of Bhutan or (iv) a Tibetan refugee who came over to India before

1st January, 1962 with the intention of permanently settling in India or (v) a person of Indian origin who has migrated from Pakistan, Burma, Sri Lanka, East African countries of Kenya, Uganda, the United Republic of Tanzania (formerly Tanganyika and Zanzibar), Zambia, Malawi, Zaire, Ethiopia and Vietnam with the intention of permanently settling in India, provided that a candidate belonging to categories SBI Recruitment 2010.

(ii), (iii), (iv) and (v) above shall be a person in whose favour a certificate of eligibility has been issued by the Government of India. A candidate in whose case a certificate of eligibility is necessary, may be admitted to the examination/interview conducted by the Bank but on final selection, the offer of
