We use the article "a" if the noun it describes begins with a **consonant sound** (not just a consonant).

Example: a dog (consonant /d/ sound); a helicopter (consonant /h/ sound) an apple (vowel /a/ sound); an honor (silent h, vowel /o/ sound)
