

Leaf Writing Activities / Ideas:

I'm lucky enough to have tons of beautiful colorful leaves to use during the autumn season. If you aren't as lucky as me you can still do these activities using felt and paper leaves.

1. Place a handful of colorful leaves on the table have your students select a leaf and then describe it using "colorful language". Have students read their descriptions and then show their leaves. Students can comment on each others descriptions and make suggestions on words that could be added. (writing paper included)
2. Students can select a leaf to glue on their paper. Students can add to the leaf and make a leaf creation such as a leaf person or animal and then write a narrative about what they created. (recording sheet included)
3. Students can examine the different colored leaves and write a poem about the colors they see using similes (a template is included in this pack)
4. Students can use the leaves to touch, listen to, and smell to create a sensory poem about leaves (templates included)
