

TYPES OF POETRY:

I. SOUND AND SENSE POETRY:

A. one word	Leaves
B. two words	Red, shell
C. three words	Fall to earth
D. four words	The leaves have
E. five words	Fallen to earth
F. six words	Orange, Brown
G. seven words	Fall

II. SOUND AND EFFECT POETRY: (needs 3 cause-and-effect statements)

Because a little girl's shoe was untied,
She tripped and fell.
Because she tripped and fell,
She crushed a yellow daisy.
Because she crushed a yellow daisy,
There was no "leaf" for a moment.
Because there was no leaf,
It has got used and strong, easily carrying a value
Because the leaf along the leaf,
She dropped the value on the sidewalk.
All, because the little girl's shoe was untied.

III. PERSONIFICATION POETRY: When non-human objects (clouds, grass, leaf) are given human characteristics (sings, shouts, whispering). Remember to describe the object as if it were a person.

Examples:	
The trees danced	The leaves whispered
The sun smiled	The too-little song
The clouds were angry	The wind effect fell

The dark clouds growled softly across the sky.
The trees trembled gently in the wind.
The thunder growled for all to hear.
The storm arrived, the drought did end.
