

Follow Instructions



1. Read through the following instructions carefully first.
2. Write your name(s) in the left-hand column.
3. Draw a circle around the word *sentence* in column (a).
4. Draw two straight lines in the right-hand box above.
5. Put an "S" under each *the*.
6. Put a capital *S* over each *the*.
7. Write your first name in the middle box above.
8. Write the *1* over the *the*.
9. Put a comma after the word *the* in the line.
10. Underline sentence 2.
11. Write "123 456" and write your name in the following box. 
12. Underline the sentence with sentence 4.
13. When you see this in sentence 4, stop your hand before the *the* and start again.
14. Write your teacher's name in the box. 

15. Cross out the second *the* in the sentence which begins with the word *and*.
16. Draw a line in the box in the bottom right-hand corner of the page.
17. Draw a picture of the *the* in the first sentence in the column (a) box.
18. When you see this in sentence 4, say to yourself "There are *the* in sentence 4".
19. Cross out the *the* in the first *the* sentence and write the word in the following circle.



20. Put a capital *S* over the "the" in the first sentence.
21. Find the word *the* which is not in the sentence and underline it.
22. When you see this in sentence 4, stop in the first *the* and say to a friend "There are *the* in 4".
23. Cross out all the odd numbers in front of each sentence.
24. Now draw a line through all the sentences, but write your name here without answering any other questions.
