

Time Lines for Telling Time

for Elementary Students (Book Lesson Plan)

Grade Level(s): (Integrates 1)

Subject(s):

- Mathematics

Description: Understanding time can be very difficult for young children. One way of helping students understand the flow of time is to use time lines. This lesson uses the daily classroom routine to provide a visual and meaningful reinforcement of the concept.

Goal: The students will understand how time divides the day.

Objectives: (Students will)

- Make a drawing of a classroom activity and note its approximate time.
- Discuss the placement of an illustrated note on the timeline.

Background Information: This activity can be used with students of higher levels through modification. This lesson teaches students through the routine's own built-in schedule for when students can use it for understanding historical events or as an autobiography activity.

Materials:

- Activities
- Clocks
- Paper
- Pencils

Procedure:

1. Discuss the activities that the class does yesterday. List these things on the board or on a chart paper. There may include everything from going outside to learning for the test.
2. Explain the format each of these activities.
3. Have each student choose one of the activities listed.
