


Addition Word Problems

a




At the circus, Kenny saw 12 tigers, 14 horses, and 22 monkeys. How many animals did he see in all?

b




When Sandra went to the seashore, she counted 28 starfish, 32 fish, and 46 shells. How many things did she see in all?
