

### Directions for 7<sup>th</sup> Grade Pronoun Test:

1-Given five sentences with a noun underlined, you will have to rewrite a personal pronoun to replace that underlined noun and say if it is a pronoun in the nominative or the objective case.

Ex: The boy walks his dog. Answer: he walks his dog. Nominative = Subject

2-Given five sentences, you will have to circle the correct pronoun after than or as.

Ex: My brother is taller than (I, me). Answer = I

3- Given five sentences with blanks, you will have to fill in with a POSSESSIVE/Possessive pronoun.

Ex: The teacher told me to put \_\_\_\_\_ on the desk. Possible answers = mine, his, ours, etc.

4- Given three sentences, you will need to circle the compound sentences, and say whether they are intensive or reflexive.

Ex: He asked himself a question. Answer = himself, reflexive

5- Given five sentences, you will have to underline the interrogative pronoun and tell whether it is Nominative or Objective.

Ex: Which of the students is the oldest? Answer = Which = Nominative (Subject)

6- Given five sentences with blanks in them, you will have to fill in with the correct interrogative pronoun, who or whose.

Ex: \_\_\_\_\_ did you ask that question? answer = who

7- Given five sentences, you will have to:

- find the relative pronoun, - underline the adjective clause, and - circle the pronoun's antecedent (the noun in front of it that it modifies).

Ex: The girl who sits in front of me is tall. Relative pronoun = who  
adjective clause = who sits in front of me, antecedent = girl

8- Given ten sentences, you will have to identify the underlined pronoun as: interrogative, demonstrative, indefinite, distributive, or possessive.
