

Using decimals, percentages and fractions

Here are some examples of how to read numbers:

Money: Pounds are represented by numbers, cents by points

10.00	ten pounds
10.05	ten pounds and five pence
10.10	ten pounds and ten pence
10.20	ten pounds and twenty pence
10.50	ten pounds and fifty pence
10.99	ten pounds and ninety-nine pence
10.000	ten pounds and no pence

Decimals: Before this point the number is read as usual, after the point each digit is read by itself

10.1	ten and one tenth
10.10	ten and one hundredth
10.11	ten and eleven hundredths
10.111	ten and eleven thousandths

Percentages

10%	ten per cent
10.1%	ten and one tenth per cent
10.11%	ten and eleven hundredths per cent

Fractions

10	ten
10.1	ten and one tenth
10.10	ten and one hundredth
10.11	ten and eleven hundredths
10.111	ten and eleven thousandths
