It is my policy and that of Glen Oaks Elementary that students in the Choir maintain a code of conduct that is fair to all students. Students in this choir chose to participate and work on music that excels that of the regular classroom experience. Students who constantly disrupt the progress of the choir will be asked to rethink his or her choice. Students in this choir will be performing off campus and must represent Glen Oaks in a sterling manner. From time to time, I will send home news of progress with students who are having difficulty keeping the policy. Each time a student is disruptive, I will hand the student a Popsicle stick to let them know they have been warned. When a student accumulates three in one 40-minute rehearsal, they will receive a report to take home. After a student has received three reports, he or she will permanently be dismissed from choir for the year. I feel this is more than generous for a group of this caliber. Below I have listed possible violations. Choir is a privilege and control and mutual respect must be maintained at all times. I ask that younger siblings not come to school until the beginning of the regular school day. For a fee, arrangements with Club 360 can be made. I look forward to a very musical season.
