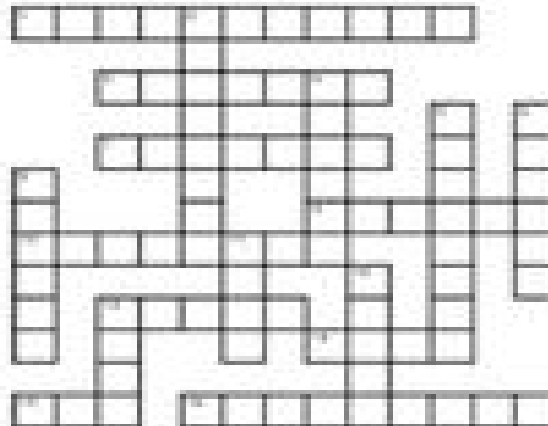


Sewing Terms Crossword Puzzle

Across

1. It holds the fabric in place when the needle is stitching the fabric on a sewing machine. (7,4)
2. It prevents your finger or your arm, by hand, it can be used to guide the needle through the fabric. (7)
3. This type of stitching is temporary to hold fabric in place and then pulled out later in the project. (7)
4. This is threaded and used to sew fabric together. (6)
5. An iron is used to do this. Steam can be used. The iron is held in one place at a time while doing this. (7)
6. These thread cones are one of these. (2)
7. These are used to hold fabric together before the fabric goes through the sewing machine. (4)
8. The finished edge on the bottom of a dress or skirt. (2)
9. The "pretty side" of the fabric. The part of the fabric with the design or by design on the outside of the garment or craft project. (7,4)

1. They are used to sew fabric. (4)
2. A fabric that comes up the inside seams of a garment or used on the inside of a tote bag. (4)

1. These help move the fabric through the sewing machine by guiding the fabric with metal teeth. (4,4)
2. This is used to hold the fabric together in a finished garment or craft project. (6)
3. This can be used to open and close a bag on the back of a dress. (2)
4. A valuable tool in the sewing room to give a garment a finished look. It is used after sewing seams together. (4)
5. A three layered item with stitching through all three layers to hold them together. It can be used as a food spread. (7)
6. The line of stitching holding pieces of fabric together for coats or clothing. (4)
