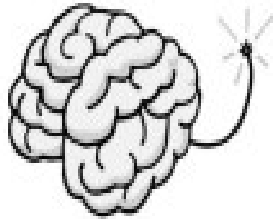

Anger Management Worksheet 4-1: Naming Types and Variations of Anger (Skill 4)
