Grade Level(s):

Subject(s):

- Language Arts/Reading

Duration: 30-45 minutes

Key Objectives: Developmental reading for elementary students. Comparing and contrasting the two stories using a Venn Diagram.

Skills: Using a Venn Diagram to compare and contrast two versions of a story.

Prerequisite Knowledge: The students will have prior knowledge of the story the "The Three Little Pigs" and some of the students may have the sequel "The True Story of the 3 Little Pigs by A. Wolf".

Assessment: The children may be asked to write what they would do "The Three Little Pigs" is about. Some of the children may be asked to answer they can compare some of the events and what they

2. Identify the plot of the two stories.
3. Explain the climax and the endings of the two stories.
4. Create a Venn Diagram.
