


RULES! RULES! RULES!

Do this! Do that! It never seems to end, does it? The poor old music notes are in the same fix as you. They have rules that MUST be followed. Here are four music rules.

1. ANY NOTE THAT LIVES BETWEEN TWO LINES ON A STAFF IS CALLED A SPACE NOTE.  OR 

2. ANY NOTE THAT LIVES WITH A STAFF LINE GOING THROUGH THE MIDDLE OF IT IS CALLED A LINE NOTE.  OR 

3. IF ANY NOTE LIVES ON OR ABOVE THE MIDDLE LINE OF A STAFF, THE STEM (OR STICK) OF THAT NOTE GOES DOWN ON THE LEFT SIDE. 

4. IF ANY NOTE LIVES BELOW THE MIDDLE LINE OF A STAFF, THE STEM GOES UP ON THE RIGHT SIDE. 


Whew!!! That is a lot to remember. Let's use those rules so they make sense.
