## RULES! RULES! RULES!

Do this! Do that! It never seems to end, does it? The poor old music notes are in the same fix as you. They have rules that MUST be followed. Here are four music rules.

- 1. ANY NOTE THAT LIVES BETWEEN TWO LINES ON A STAFF IS CALLED A SPACE NOTE. OR
- 2. Any note that lives with a staff line going through the middle of it is called a <u>line note</u>. Or
- 3. If any note lives on or above the middle line of a staff, the stem (or stick) of that note goes down on the <u>left</u> side.
- 4. IF ANY NOTE LIVES BELOW THE MIDDLE LINE OF A STAFF, THE STEM GOES UP ON THE RIGHT SIDE.

Whew!!! That is a lot to remember. Let's the those rules so they make sense.
