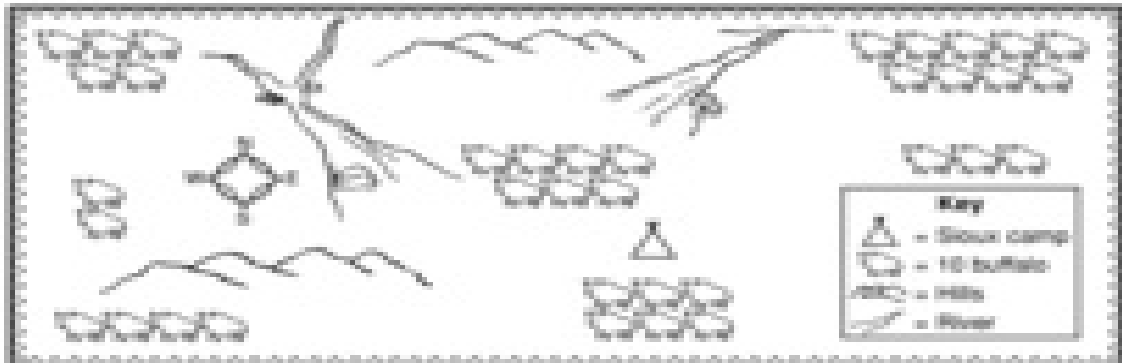

Following the Buffalo

Find the Sioux camp on the map below. Use the map key to help you.
Follow the directions below to complete the map.



1. In October, the band traveled south from their camp and located a large herd. Draw a yellow tepee next to this herd to show where they set up camp.
2. In early November, the band traveled west and located a smaller herd. Draw a red tepee next to this herd.
3. By March, supplies were low and the band needed to hunt more buffalo. They traveled north and located a small herd. Draw an orange tepee next to this herd.
4. In May, the band needed buffalo skins to make new clothes. They traveled farther north and located a large herd. Draw a green tepee next to this herd.
5. During the summer months, bands often camped together as tribes. The tribe needed lots of buffalo meat. They traveled east and located the largest herd of all. Draw a blue tepee next to this herd.
6. In September, the band traveled south and located a small herd. Draw a purple tepee next to this herd.
7. Cold weather was coming and the band needed food for the winter. They traveled west and located a large herd. Draw a brown tepee next to this herd.
