- 1- Given five sentences you must circle the correct pronoun (one will be from the nom. case, one will be from the obj. case).
- 2 – Given five sentences with an italicized pronoun in each sentence, you will have to give the person (first, second, third), the number (singular, plural), and the gender (male, female, neuter, m/f). of each pronoun.
- 3 – Given five sentences, you will have to underline the compound pronoun in each sentence.
- 4 – Given five sentences, you will have to circle the correct nominative pronoun, and state whether it is a Subject or a Subject Compliment.
- 5 – Given five sentences, you will have to circle the correct pronoun and state whether it is a Direct Object or an Object of Preposition.
- 6 – Given five sentences with blanks, you will have to fill in each blank with a possessive pronoun that fits in the sentence.
7. Given five sentences, you will have to circle the correct word in parenthesis (a possessive pronoun or a contraction).
