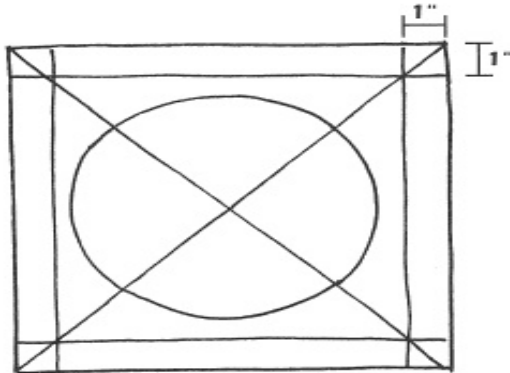
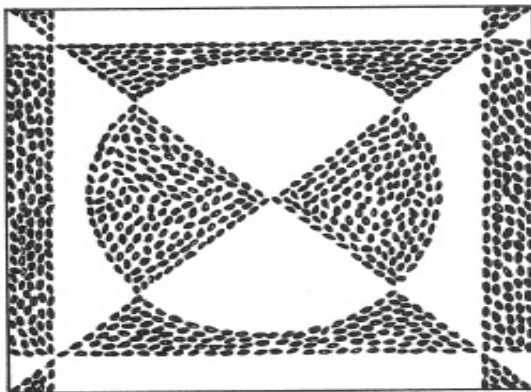


- 4.** Repeat step 3 on the other three sides of the cardboard square to make a border around the circle.



- 5.** Take a dark bean, and put a drop of glue on it. Place this bean at the center point of the design. Continue to fill in the design with the other dark beans, using the picture here as a guide.



- 6.** When you've glued all of the dark beans to the cardboard, fill in the design with the light beans.

## ROMULUS AND REMUS

The ancient Romans believed in an old legend, or story, that their nation was founded by twin brothers named Romulus and Remus. The city of Rome is named for Romulus. The story tells that when the twins were babies, a wicked king put them in a basket and dropped them in a river called the Tiber. But the basket floated to shore, and the boys were rescued by a female wolf. The wolf nursed them and kept them safe until they were grown. Because of this legend, the symbol for the modern city of Rome is a wolf. To this day, wolves live in a cage on a hill called the Capitoline in the middle of the city of Rome!
