9 [Unit 11: Possession]

Use

We use **'s** to show possession [when something/someone belongs to a person or people].

Singular nouns:

1. If the owner is singular and doesn't end in **s**, we add **'s**.

Example: the pen of Sarah – Sarah**'s** pen

2. If the owner is singular and ends in **s**, we only add **'**.

Example: the pen of Charles – Charles**'** pen

Plural nouns:

1. If the owner is plural and doesn't end in **s**, we add **'s**.

Example: the shoes of the boys – the boys**'s** shoes

2. If the owner is plural and ends in **s**, we only add **'**.

Example: the books of the students – the students**'** books

3. If we talk of two owners making the same thing, we place the **'s** on the second owner.

Example: the house of mother and father – mother and father**'s** house

4. If we talk of two owners owning the individual items, we place the **'s** on both the owners.

Example: the car of my mother and father – my mother**'s** and father**'s** cars
