Course Request Worksheet**

Next year grade 10

All St. Charles High School students are required to be full time students. This means that you must enroll in eight classes each semester. Lunch, study hall, and unscheduled first/eighth count as classes.

You will not be able to use Home Access Center to request courses at the Fox Valley Career Center or Elgin Community College. If you wish to take these off-campus courses, tell your counselor when you meet with him/her in February.

When you enter your requests in Home Access Center, you will see some classes listed with the word "Block" in the course title and course numbers that end with "7." Block courses represent full-year courses. For example, if you wish to enroll in English 10, which is listed as HE0221 first semester and HE0222 second semester, you will actually enroll in English 10 Block, HE0227.

Use the *Course Offering Book and Planning Guide* to determine course numbers and course titles.

Use the worksheet below to design your schedule. Your count of class periods must add up to 16: 8 periods first semester and 8 periods second semester.
