Guiding Questions

Unit 1

- 1. Can students demonstrate their comprehension of grade appropriate text by answering literal and inferential questions?
- 2. Can students define folktales?
- 3. Can students identify and compare the cultural context of folklore to real life and other texts?
- 4. Can students make inferences or draw intended conclusions about theme based on text through thinking inductively and deductively?
- 5. Can students analyze character traits, thoughts, words and actions to make inferences about a character's motives?
- 6. Can students identify and compare/contrast elements of folktales to other folklore and genres (historical and realistic fiction)?
- 7. Can students identify use of literary devices to better comprehend text (exaggeration/hyperbole and personification)?
- 8. Can students use the writing process to create compositions that include well developed characters, dialogue, theme, and literary devices?
- 9. Can students work cooperatively to establish group expectations, apply agreed upon rules, and assume a variety of roles?
- 10. Can students work cooperatively in a group setting to have formal and informal conversations?
