

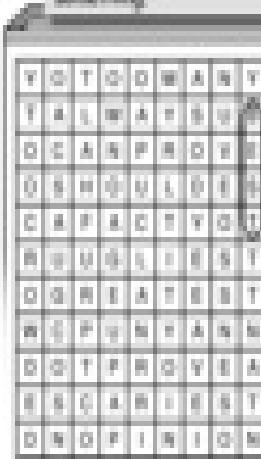
MARK UP WORDS
