Component Descriptions

Controlling Question (10 points): A one or two sentence question that guides the focus of the research.

Preliminary Works Cited (10 points): MLA format list of possible sources (book, magazine, internet) that might be useful.

Rough Outline (10 points): A rough outline of what you plan, at this point, to cover in the essay.

Research Notes (60 points): A minimum of 60 total notes, including quotation, paraphrase, and summary cards.

Revised, Referenced Outline (20 points): A formal topic outline containing references to note cards.

Rough Draft (20 points): A first draft of the essay based on the topic outline, incorporating information from note cards.

Abstract (10 points): A 100 word statement that summarizes your essay.

Draft Bibliography (10 points): A rough draft of your bibliography in MLA format. See requirements for source cards.

Final Manuscript (200 points): Requirements: title page; abstract; topic outline; essay/project; works cited page.
