* If the regular adjective has one syllable, add —er to the end to make the comparative form.

(Make the second consonant double if you have a consonant-vowel-consonant pattern word.)

* If the regular adjective ends in y, change the y to i before adding — er.

 For many regular adjective with two or more syllables, use the word more before the adjective and do not add -er.

* Note these irregular forms: good becomes better, bad becomes worse, and far becomes farther.
