



Article I – Name and Purpose

Palo Alto High School ASB Constitution

Ratified Friday, February 9th 2007



The name of this organization shall be the Associated Student Body (ASB) of Palo Alto High School.

This organization shall have as its purpose, the conduct of activities on behalf of the students of Palo Alto High School as approved by the principal and the governing board of the Palo Alto Unified School District.

Article II – Membership

All students enrolled in Palo Alto High School shall be members of the ASB. Members shall be entitled to vote in all student body general elections.

Article III – Executive Board

The Executive Board shall consist of the following elected ASB officers:

- President
- Vice-president
- Secretary
- Treasurer

The Executive Board shall have all executive powers.

The Executive Board members shall serve as both acting and voting members of the Palo Alto High School Student Council.

The four positions on the Executive Board shall be filled by a general election of the student body.

All members of the Executive Board must be enrolled in 4th period leadership for the length of their term.

No member of the Executive Board may hold more than one ASB office.

Executive Board members shall hold office for one school year (Fall 2006).

The duties of the Executive Board members are outlined in the Bylaws to the Constitution.

Article IV – Student Council

The legislative power of the ASB shall be vested in the student council.

The student council shall consist of the following elected ASB officers:

- All members of the ASB Executive Board
- Athletic Commissioner (Spring 2007)
- 2 Social Commissioners (Spring 2007)
- 4 Class Presidents (one from each class)
- 4 Class Vice Presidents (one from each class)
- 3 TEAM Representatives, with no voting power (Fall 2007)

And the following appointed ASB officers:

- Web Design/Communications Officer (Fall 2006)
- 2 Spirit Commissioners
- PAUSD Board Representative
- 4 PALY Site Council Representatives (one from each class)
