

**RÉSIST**

Final Project : Write a speech or the lyrics to a protest song.

You may choose between options A or B :

Option A : You are a teenager or a young adult living in the 1960's. You have been on marches with Martin Luther King and you have been to Woodstock. You now want to express yourself by writing your own protest song or a speech.

Option B : The time is the present. As yourself, or adopting the role of another person/character, you want to express yourself and protest against something you think is wrong. You decide to write a speech or a protest song.

Instructions :

-You must protest against something (or someone) ; We must be able to have a good idea from your words or lyrics what you are protesting against.

-Your ideas must be persuasive and convincing.

-You must be able to explain, in a short text (about 150 words/letter you will write in addition to your song/speech).

The following points : 1) What you are protesting against and why?

2) Who your song/speech is addressed to ; who the audience/public is

3) How your song/speech will help contribute to a solution

Chiffres de révision :
