- Essay from <u>Number the Stars</u> Choose one of the following themes to write an essay on. Make sure to include support from the text for your opinions
 - a. Friendship
 - i. Define the terms friend and best friend. How are they different and the same? Describe Annemarie and Ellen's friendship.

 - How do friendships change over time? How can friendships be tested? How is Annemarie and Ellen's friendship

 - iv. How did their friendship affect the outcome of the novel?
