Possessive Nouns/Showing Ownership

A possessive noun shows who or what something belongs to. Singular nouns are made possessive by adding 's.

Example: *The book that belongs to Laci* is on the table. → *Laci's book* is on the table.

Example: *The tail of the dog* is wagging. → *The dog's tail* is wagging.
