1. Your class had a pizza party. $\frac{3}{8}$ of one pizza was left over, and $\frac{4}{8}$ of another pizza was left over. You put them both into one box. How much pizza do you have altogether?
2. After a party, $\frac{5}{8}$ of the cake is left over. That night, big brother eats $\frac{2}{8}$ of the cake. How much is left over after that?
3. You have $7\frac{5}{8}$ feet of yarn to make a bracelet. You only use $4\frac{1}{8}$ yards for the bracelet. How much yarn is left over?
4. A cake recipe requires $\frac{3}{5}$ cup of sugar for the frosting and $\frac{1}{5}$ cup of sugar for the cake. How much sugar is that altogether?
5. You walk $\frac{3}{10}$ of a mile to your friend's house, and then $\frac{5}{10}$ of a mile to school. How far did you walk altogether?
