3. Three fifths of the animals on my farm are sheep. We have 45 sheep. One fifth are goats. One fifth are pigs. How many pigs do we have?
4. I won a 6-pound chocolate bar and broke it into 5 equal parts. How much did $\frac{2}{5}$ of the chocolate bar weigh?
5. Maria gave my 50 yards of fabric with which to sew. $\frac{2}{3}$ of the fabric will be used for curtains. How much fabric will be used for curtains?
