Remember:

To make the positive present perfect tense, use: Have/has+ past participle (ed / "irregular verb" or by changing the verb "irregular verb")

Negative: Just put 'not' after 'have' or 'has' / Questions: put 'have' or 'has' in front of the subject

WH questions: we just put the question word before 'have' or 'has'



Remember:

Past participle indicates past or completed action or time. It is often called the 'ed' form as it is formed by adding *d* or *ed*.
