Remember the previous game set up from the previous day. Each ship occupies a specific coordinate that squares are all considered as a "player's ship". They cannot be "sunk" or "sunk" until they are "sunk". On coordinate, use letters for the type of ship and the number of squares occupied. Use the same board coordinate system as before. The board is divided into 10 columns (A-J) and 10 rows (1-10). The player's first choice of ship is "A" or "B" and "A" has a length of 5 squares. The second choice of a ship is "C" or "D" and "C" has a length of 3 squares. The third choice of a ship is "E" or "F" and "E" has a length of 3 squares. The fourth choice of a ship is "G" or "H" and "G" has a length of 2 squares. The fifth choice of a ship is "I" or "J" and "I" has a length of 2 squares. The sixth choice of a ship is "K" or "L" and "K" has a length of 2 squares. The seventh choice of a ship is "M" or "N" and "M" has a length of 2 squares.
